Expand Education Programming

We utilize our Empowering Transformation for Community Health (ETCH) model to expand leadership and educational programs. The ETCH model incorporates adult learning principles to enhance personal and professional development while complementing traditional academic pursuits. By focusing on transformative learning experiences, ETCH aims to shift mindsets, foster leadership skills, and promote social change.

Build the Capacity of the Oral Health Workforce

AIDPH was founded on the principles of investing in the oral health workforce. We believe that all oral health professionals play a crucial role in advancing access to care, improving the quality-of-care delivery, and reducing oral health disparities. This theme spans our research, education, and advocacy programming for partners to build a comprehensive strategy in addressing workforce needs, starting with educational and academic spaces into continuing education and professional development.

Establish Endowment Funds

Additionally, establishing an endowment fund with AIDPH can ensure the sustainability of oral health initiatives, provide scholarships for research, or fund specific positions within our organization. Funders can support annual award stipends for periods of five to ten years, demonstrating a long-term commitment to our goals.
